Torrens Road to River Torrens (T2T) construction works to commence

Welcome to the first T2T Alliance construction newsletter. During the life of the project, construction newsletters will be produced and circulated to the local community on a quarterly basis to provide information about upcoming construction activities and other project activities of interest. A website dedicated to provide up-to-date information on construction activities has also been established and will provide another avenue for community members and road users to be kept informed of the project's progress. Since the beginning of June, the T2T Alliance (Leighton Contractors, York Civil, Aurecon Australia and the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure) has been busy setting up offices at the Ridley Street compound. At the peak period, approximately 500 workers will be supported by the project.

Detailed design work, including the urban design elements of the project are currently underway. Planning for the first construction activities is well advanced and a range of activities will soon commence.

Construction Program Overview

For construction the project footprint is divided into 12 work zones.

Work zones 1 – 6 are south of Port Road to the River Torrens and work zones 7 – 12 are north of Port Road to Torrens Road. A map showing the construction footprint and geographical areas within each of the work zones are on the project website.

Service Relocation Works

Service relocation works have been in progress for some time. Activities will increase significantly during July and August 2015, with multiple utility service providers working in side streets and major South Road intersections between Hindmarsh Avenue

and Torrens Road. An indicative Services Utility Works (SUW) information map has been recently distributed to 1500 properties adjacent to these works. Ongoing service relocation works will continue into 2016 and an updated SUW information map will be distributed to directly affected properties, as the works progress.

Construction Timeline

An indicative timeline of key construction activities are noted below and may be subject to change as further design work continues. Updates to the timeline will be posted on the project website.

- **August 2015** – Drainage and service relocation works (eastern side of South Road)
- **September 2015 – March 2016** – Northbound surface road construction works (western side of South Road between Hindmarsh Avenue and Port Road)
- **Late 2015 – March 2016** – Southbound surface road construction works (eastern side of South Road) between Port Road and Forster Street
- **September 2015 – June 2016** – Northbound surface road construction works (western side of South Road between Port Road and Torrens Road)
- **February 2016 – May 2016** – Noise walls will be installed on a progressive basis commencing near the Hindmarsh Avenue

end and be completed before the traffic is switched over onto the newly completed northbound surface road

- **March 2016** – Traffic will be switched over to the northbound surface road (south of Port Road)
- **March 2016 – early 2017** – Construction of the Grange Road bridge and Hawker / Hurtle Street bridge and Outer Harbor rail bridge
- **May 2016** – Traffic will be switched over to the northbound surface road (north of Port Road)
- **May 2016 – July 2017** – Construction of the Port Road bridge
- **August 2016 – project completion (2018)** – Lowered road construction

Advance notice of any traffic or access changes during construction works will be provided.

Urban design elements and landscaping treatments will be undertaken towards the end of the project.

Noise façade treatments to some properties will be undertaken during 2016 – 2017. Further information about this process will be provided to property owners in the coming months.

Other Upcoming Activities July – September 2015

Over the next couple of months there will be other activities along the road corridor, including:

- Tree removals along South Road and the Port Road intersection, in preparation for major construction works
- Soil sampling on the eastern side of South Road in spot locations
- Other survey works
