The T2T Alliance is committed to contributing to the development of infrastructure in a sustainable manner through the minimisation of impacts to, and enhancement of where practicable, the local environment, workforce, community and economy. We will seek opportunities to go beyond current legal requirements and business as usual to deliver value for the project's stakeholders.

To work towards this vision we will:

- Provide a supportive project culture that encourages behaviours that challenge traditional thinking, enables innovation which generates value to stakeholders, and contributes to the delivery of infrastructure sustainability.
- Integrate sustainability principles into the day to day management of the project to improve productivity and quality outcomes.
- Adopt sustainable procurement practices which encourage a lasting supply chain legacy by incorporating environmental and social performance in subcontractor selection; adopting a preference for local industry participation and encouraging the supply chain to adopt sustainability practices and products which create value for their business.
- Minimise environmental impacts through the efficient use of resources including materials, energy and water; undertake responsible waste management, minimise discharges to air, water and land; and enable positive biodiversity benefits.
- Engage with relevant stakeholders and community representatives on a regular basis and incorporate their feedback into decision making where practicable.
- Create a sense of place through urban design including the activation of surplus land for community and environmental benefit.
- Provide Alliance members with a positive legacy where the value of sustainability in project delivery can be captured and utilised in future projects, including the merits of ISCA's Infrastructure Sustainability Rating scheme to encourage sustainability outcomes.
