



# Changes to traffic arrangements on Port Road

APRIL 2016

The T2T Alliance has successfully completed the Stage 1 traffic switch on South Road. This traffic switch will allow for the construction of a new bridge at the South Road intersection with Grange Road/Manton Street.

The next two traffic switches are scheduled to take place on the night of Wednesday 27 April 2016 and the weekend of 7–8 May 2016. Once completed, these critical works will allow construction of a new bridge at the South Road intersection with Port Road.

**This fact sheet provides more detail about the traffic arrangements on Port Road once the traffic switches are completed.**

## Traffic switch staging – Stages 2 & 3

### Stage 2: Scheduled for 27 April 2016

- U-turn facilities will be installed on Port Road near Coglein Street and at Queen Street
- Right turns from South Road into Port Road will be banned from 27 April 2016 and motorists will need to use the new u-turn facilities on Port Road
- The South Road intersection with Port Road will continue to operate as a signalised intersection for through traffic in all directions

### Stage 3: Scheduled for 7–8 May 2016

- The signalised u-turn facilities on Port Road near Coglein Street and at Queen Street will remain in place
- The South Road intersection with Port Road will be realigned to the east to allow for the Port Road bridge construction
- A new South Road carriageway between Port Road and the rail line at Euston Terrace will be in place

## Pedestrians and cyclists

Signalised pedestrian facilities will be in place on Port Road near Coglein Street and at Queen Street and on each side of the Port Road intersection with South Road. Cyclists can dismount their bicycles to cross at these pedestrian facilities. Dedicated cycle lanes will also be available on both sides of Port Road.

## Bus users

Following the Stage 3 traffic switch, the city bound bus stop on the north-east side of Port Road (Bus Stop 10) will be relocated 85 metres west to the other side of Queen Street. The out-bound bus stop on the south side of Port Road opposite Coglein Street (Bus Stop 8) will be relocated 100 metres east, closer to the city. Signage will be in place to advise bus users of these changes.

## Important information

### Stage 2

- **Port Road will be OPEN to traffic AT ALL TIMES during the Stage 2 traffic switch on the night of 27 April 2016**
- Following the Stage 2 traffic switch, motorists wishing to turn right from South Road into Port Road will need to use the new u-turn facilities near Coglein Street and at Queen Street

### Stage 3

- **Temporary traffic arrangements and clearly marked detour routes will be in place to direct road users around the works at the South Road intersection with Port Road during the Stage 3 traffic switch on 7–8 May 2016**
- The Stage 3 traffic switch will be complete by 6am Monday 9 May 2016
- Local residents and businesses will receive advance notifications and access to businesses will be maintained

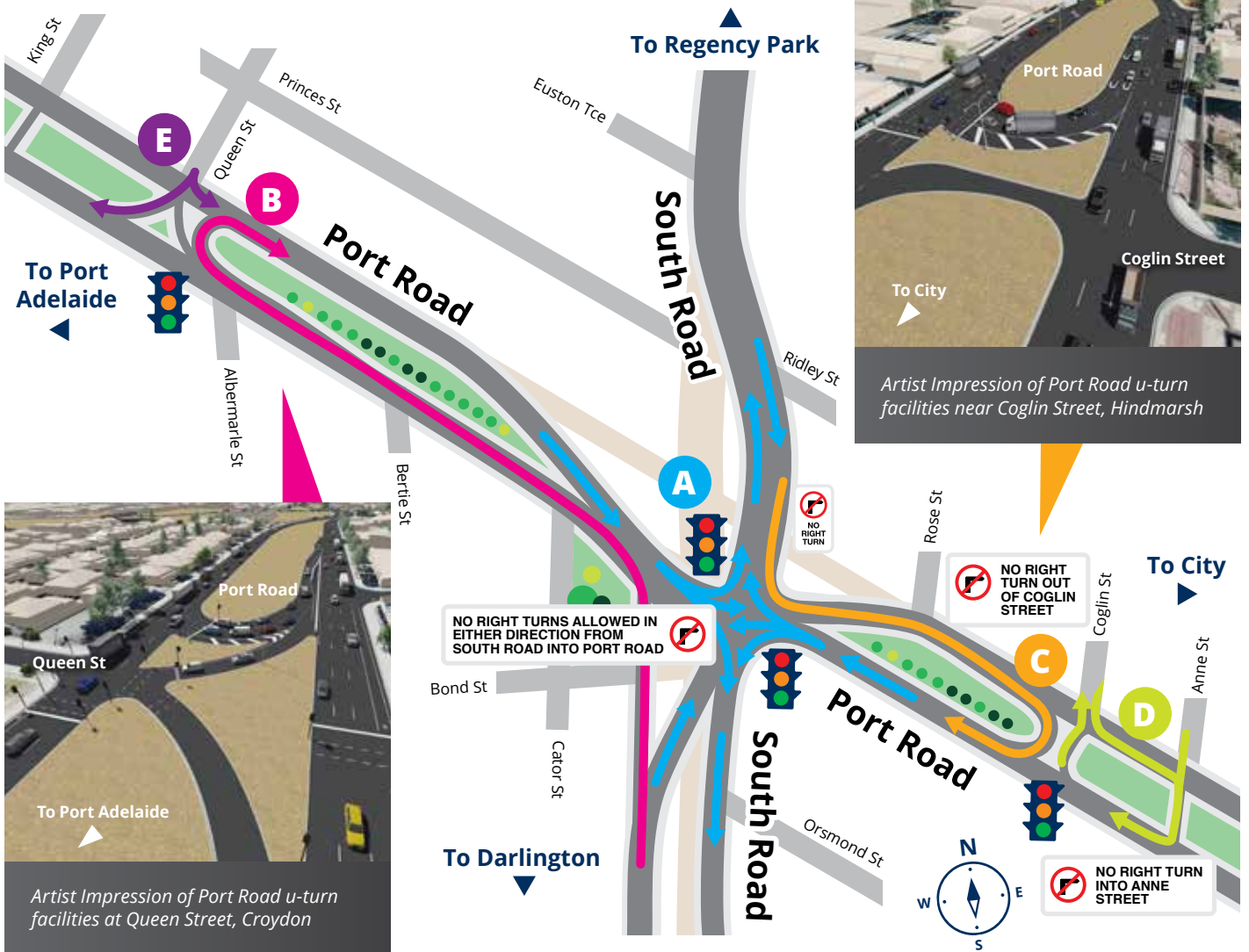

# Traffic arrangements in place on Port Road following completion of Stage 2 and 3 traffic switches



**A** All existing traffic movements for Port Road (east and westbound) permitted at the realigned South Road intersection with Port Road. All right turns from South Road from either direction into Port Road will be banned. Motorists will need to use the new u-turn facilities near Coglin Street and at Queen Street.

**B** Northbound motorists wishing to turn right from South Road into Port Road (toward the city) will need to turn left into Port Road (to head westbound toward Port Adelaide) via the slip lane. Motorists then need to use one of the two right turn lanes on Port Road to make a u-turn at the Queen Street signalised intersection to head eastbound towards the city.

**C** Southbound motorists on South Road wishing to turn right into Port Road (towards Port Adelaide) will need to turn left into Port Road (to head eastbound towards the city) via the slip lane. Motorists then need to use one of the two right turn lanes on Port Road to make a u-turn at the traffic signals near Coglin Street to head westbound towards Port Adelaide.

**D** After the Stage 2 traffic switch, motorists wishing to turn right from Coglin Street into Port Road (toward Port Adelaide) will need to turn left into Port Road (toward the city). Motorists then need to do a u-turn across the Port Road median at Anne Street to head westbound towards Port Adelaide.

**E** After the traffic switches are completed on Port Road, motorists will be able to turn right or left from Queen Street into Port Road using the new signalised intersection.
