



Landscaping update

27 March 2019

Landscaping works across the project area are progressing well and the first trees have been planted near Day Terrace and Robert Street, Croydon. The planting of more than 800 trees will continue over coming weeks, followed by the planting of approximately 55,000 plants in the parks, detention basins, adjacent the rail corridor and parcels of land along South Road.

Works have started on many of the pocket parks and green areas along the surface road of South Road. Irrigation systems are being installed in many of these areas and will be followed by the placement of top soil and mulch in readiness for planting.

Jervois Avenue Park

Earthworks have been completed along with the installation of the irrigation system, placement of top soil and concrete path and edging. The fixtures in the park are now being installed including; a water fountain, fitness equipment and brick seating. Fencing for the dog park area will follow in April 2019.

Port Road median

The irrigation system and edging is being installed in front of the Model-T clubrooms near Queen Street, with placement of top soil to follow in readiness for planting.

On the eastern side of South Road irrigation has been installed and the placement of top soil and mulch has been completed.

Detention basins

Flanders Street, Harriet Street and Forster Street

- Preparation works have been completed and these areas are ready for planting to occur.

Lamont Street

- Earthworks and concreting works have been completed, and the installation of gabion walls and irrigation system are nearing completion. The placement of top soil and mulch will follow.

Princes Street

- The gabion walls have been completed along with installation of the irrigation system and placement of top soil and mulch. Current activities in this location include completing the brick seating and installing the table and seating under the shelter.
